A BILL

BILL HISTORY

In 1989, the Berlin Wall fell, setting the stage for historic change in Eastern Europe. While democracy spreads to the rest of the world, Americans tend to take it for granted. On November 9, 1993, Students for a Better America will be hosting Freedom Week. The goal of Freedom Week is to create an awareness of the meaning of freedom and a realization of the freedom we Americans take for granted.

Dr. Adam Glapinski will be the key speaker at this event, to be held November 9, 1993 in Boulder, CO. Dr. Glapinski is a member of the Polish Parliament and a Professor of Economics in Warsaw. During the Communist era, he fought for Poland's freedom and was an active member of Solidarity. After the fall of Communism in 1989, Dr. Glapinski was one of those who urged Lech Walesa, then head of Solidarity, to be a candidate for the Presidency and managed his campaign.

One of the founding members and a leader of PC, the Polish Center Party, Dr. Glapinski was elected to the Sejm, the lower House of Parliament in 1991 in the first free Parliamentary elections since before World War II. He served in the Cabinet of Prime Minister Jan Krzysztof in Bielecki. Subsequently, he was the Minister of Economic Relations with Western Europe and the United States in the Cabinet of Prime Minister Jan Olszewski.

Dr. Glapinski is an advocate of a free market economy, the privatization and demonopolization of State-owned property, and the institutionalization of a democratic form of government in Poland.

BILL SUMMARY


