BILL HISTORY

The Black Student Alliance, as a student group organization, is committed to equipping its members with the necessary skills in human engineering which will allow them to achieve self-awareness in all communities. As a recognized body of black students on this campus, the Black Student Alliance is in the role of maintaining meaningful communications with the University officials, other organizations, and the community at large.

On the weekend of November 5-6, 1993, there will be a Big Eight Conference meeting at the University of Oklahoma. At this meeting we will engage in the planning and development of the Big Eight Conference this year. The Big Eight Conference is an annual event that was established by students of the Big Eight council as an opportunity for African-American students to attend career fairs, educational workshops, profound speakers, and culturally uplifting events. The conference allocates the transference of tradition, history, and African-American culture.

By participating in the planning of the conference the Black Student Alliance at the University of Colorado will have the opportunity to initiate in programs based on the needs of African-Americans on the Boulder campus.

BILL SUMMARY

SECTION 2: Written reports and editorials shall be submitted pursuant to 36LCB#20.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.




