The African Student Alliance (Afrisa) would like to send a delegate to the African Studies Association Annual Meeting in Boston on December 3-7, 1993.

Afrisa has been operating on the CU campus for three years, from its inception in 1990. The membership of the organization is open 6 to all CU students with a keen interest on Africa, culture, 8 academic, etc. Since its inception Afrisa has functioned as a forum to bring attention to African culture and issues, and to 10 engage others in our campus community to study and discuss them. To that end it has sponsored, on our campus, fora on South Africa, Sudan and Somalia, just to mention a few. Our biggest event was a one-week long First Annual African Affairs Conference in March of 12 1993 where panels and lectures on a wide range of topics, 14 including: The Environment, Souh Africa, AIDS, women and 16 development, Religious Conflicts, and so on were presented.
