BILL HISTORY

2 The Third International Conference on Sexual Assault on Campus will
3 be held in Nashville, Tennessee on October 7-9, 1993. The
4 conference will cover a wide range of topics including peer
5 education, consciousness-raising for campus men, cooperation with
6 community and service organizations, and post-traumatic counseling
and recovery.

8 In addition, all current information and research regarding sexual
9 assault will be available at the conference. This information is
10 extremely beneficial to the University of Colorado through its
11 struggle against sexual assault and would definitely be helpful in
12 strengthening the COURAGE (CU Rape and Gender Educators) program,
13 formerly referred to as the DARE program. We hope to share the
14 knowledge gained at this conference with other Colorado colleges
15 and universities that will be attending the Colorado Conference on
16 Rape Awareness Education in Boulder, CO on October 23, 1993.

18 The International Conference is a great opportunity to meet other
19 concerned students, faculty, and administrators from various
20 universities. Networking with these other programs around the
21 nation will definitely enrich the COURAGE program and consequently
22 the students at the University of Colorado.


