BILL HISTORY

Walkabout is an undergraduate literary journal that since 1984 has provided students a climate for the free expression of the visual, fictional, and the poetic forming an important core of diversity at this university; a circulation in May 1993 of 1300 copies is indicative of the extensive interest in this function. Funded with the cooperation of the ASSG and the Department of English, Walkabout is the natural extension of the University of Colorado's mission statement that stresses the importance of research and publication in all fields, not merely in the physical sciences but also in areas as diverse as surrealist fiction, photography, and cut-up poetry.

This year Walkabout continues this tradition with a dedicated staff of five undergraduate students involved in all facets of the arts found within. These students will be involved with all aspects necessary in the publication process-not merely the selection of work, but also the initial fundraising activities and distribution of the end result. In addition, the staff of Walkabout will present a public presentation disseminating the labors of these published within.

Walkabout is scheduled for release in late March, the public reading supplementing the magazine tentatively planned to occur in April. The staff of this magazine holds the hope that this year's issue will excel its predecessors in quality and the espousal of the University of Colorado's unsaid rubric of "Diversity and Culture in All Things".
