BILL HISTORY

The Saul Lefkowitz National Moot Court Competition is a moot court competition in trademark law and unfair trade practices sponsored by the Brand Names Education Foundation. This will be the first year that the University of Colorado School of Law has been represented in the national competition. Students from the University of Colorado have historically been exceptionally competitive on a national level in a variety of moot court and trial competitions. The Brand Names Education Foundation is a notfor profit organization dedicated to promoting education in the field of trademarks and advancing the brand names concept.

The Saul Lefkowitz National Moot Court Competition is an annual event comprised of four regional competitions and a national competition. This year, a team of four students from the University of Colorado will be competing at the Western regional competition in San Francisco, California on February 26, 1994. The students will be accompanied by Law Professor Arthur Travers. They will represent the University of Colorado in the competition through both written briefs and oral arguments.
