A BILL

BILL HISTORY

2 The Saul Lefkowitz National Moot Court Competition is a moot court
competition in trademark law and unfair trade practices sponsored
4 by the Brand Names Education Foundation. This will be the first
year that the University of Colorado School of Law has been
6 represented in the national competition. Students from the
University of Colorado have historically been exceptionally
8 competitive on a national level in a variety of moot court and
trial competitions. The Brand Names Education Foundation is a not-
10 for profit organization dedicated to promoting education in the
field of trademarks and advancing the brand names concept.

12 The Saul Lefkowitz National Moot Court Competition is an annual
event comprised of four regional competitions and a national
14 competition. This year, a team of four students from the
University of Colorado will be competing at the Western regional
16 competition in San Francisco, California on February 26, 1994. The
students will be accompanied by Law Professor Arthur Travers. They
18 will represent the University of Colorado in the competition
through both written briefs and oral arguments.

BILL SUMMARY

22 This bill allocates \$660.00 plus GAR from the Council of Colleges
and Schools account #1391200 to help fund travel expenses for four
24 law students to attend the regional moot court competition of the
Saul Lefkowitz National Moot Court Competition in San Francisco,
26 California on February 26, 1994.

28 BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Colleges and Schools of the
University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

30 SECTION 1: This bill allocates \$660.00 plus GAR from the
32 Council of Colleges and Schools account #1391200 to
help fund travel expenses for four law students to
34 attend the regional moot court competition of the
Saul Lefkowitz National Moot Court Competition in
36 San Francisco, California on February 26, 1994.

SECTION 2: A report shall be submitted pursuant to 34CCSB#15.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.

BUDGET

There will be four students attending the competition. Professor Travers will pay his own expenses from his Faculty Fund.
