BILL HISTORY

The Public Interest Environmental Law Conference, held annually in Eugene, Oregon, is one of the most comprehensive meetings held in the field of environmental law. This year, there will be over 120 panels covering topics from environmental law in Vietnam to the 1872 mining law. Two board members from the Environmental Law Society (ELS), Frank Wilson, co-president, and Tom Ballanco, Environmental Action Committee (EAC) co-chair, will be attending the conference. Information gathered and contacts made at the meetings will help ELS further its goals of education and legal assistance to environmental groups. For example, there are sessions on SLAPP (Strategic Lawsuits Against Public Participationfiled by corporations against individuals to discourage protest:

12 -filed by corporations against individuals to discourage protest; the company knows that it will lose the case, but the cost to the 14 individual is damaging). The EAC has been working with environmental groups that have been the victims of SLAPP suits, and 16 information from these sessions will help the EAC better serve the groups we assist.

The University of Colorado School of Law is nationally recognized as one of the best schools for natural resources and environmental law. The ELS, the largest student group in the school, is an important factor in that ranking, providing opportunities for discussion and hands-on legal work with environmental groups. The individuals attending the conference will use the information gained there, both in the day-to-day work of the ELS and talks given to other ELS members upon their return.

We request financial assistance with the airfares to Eugene. We have arranged to stay with law students while attending the conference, will pick up own own food expenses, and the Dean of the Law School will pay for conference registration.
