BILL HISTORY

The Collegiate Entrepreneur Organizations (CEO) was founded spring semester 1994. It is open to all majors, and as of 02/21/94 has 26 members. Our academic sponsor is Dr. Dale Meyer and our business sponsor is Juan Rodriguez. The purpose of CEO is to provide students from all areas of the University the opportunity to interact, network, and learn from the entrepreneurs in Boulder.

CEO is seeking funds for our initial costs of start-up and marketing of the club. We are also seeking support for two programs we will have open to all university students. For more information on these programs we have enclosed additional notes. We intend to raise the majority of the funds in other ways but are requesting 15% support from CCS.

SECTION 2: Written reports and editorials shall be submitted pursuant to 34CCSB#15.
