A RESOLUTION

Whereas: The University of Colorado at Boulder Office of Student Affairs staff members, whether working under the direction of other University officials or of their own volition, have and are blatantly violating the UCSU/Boulder Chancellor Autonomy Agreement (December 13, 1985) by:

- .creating an intimidating environment for UCSU cost center staff;
- .excluding UCSU Executives, Legislative Council, and the entire student body from their role in management partnership of UCSU Cost Centers with Administration;
- .preventing and discouraging open communication between the relevant parties regarding the potential University Medical Group Practice (UMGP) and Wardenburg Student Health Center merger; and
- .not being honest and forthright with UCSU regarding their position on this issue.

Whereas: While we recognize that the Office of Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs is essential to ensure the quality of student life and maintain student representation to the Chancellor and Central Administration, the individuals currently working in the Office of Vice Chancellor for

Student Affairs are displaying blatant disregard of their responsibilities to the students for whom they work and are supposed to represent.

Whereas: We also recognize that a number of other University of Colorado offices are involved in the CU Plus/Wardenburg issue, including at least, the Office of Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs (Boulder Campus), the Office of Budget and Finance (CU Central Administration), and the Office of Compensation Services in the Division of Human Resources (Boulder Campus).

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

Section 1: The University of Colorado Student Union (UCSU) casts a vote of no confidence in the aforementioned offices and their officers based upon information provided from various constituencies and from documents provided to the UCSU Legislative Council and the Executives during the December 2, 1993 UCSU Legislative Council Meeting.

Section 2: That the UCSU Legislative Council and the Executives will not tolerate the use of intimidation tactics on any student or UCSU Cost Center employee, be they student or non-student.

Section 3: That the appropriate University offices along with the Board of Regents and the President work in conjunction with the University of Colorado Student Union elected and appointed officials to conduct an investigation of the allegations of administrative misconduct, coercion, and intimidation.

Section 4: That this inquiry is to begin upon passage of this resolution with appropriate disciplinary actions to be taken.


Section 5: The UCSU Legislative Council and Executives demand that the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs, Jean Delaney, come before Legislative Council to answer allegations of misconduct and reveal the sources of the alleged intimidation along with all individuals involved and the reasoning behind such actions.

Section 6: That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the
aforementioned offices as well as the Office of the
Chancellor (Boulder), President, Board of Regents,
University Hospital President, and any other
relevant parties.
