A RESOLUTION

Whereas: The UCSU Legislative Council and Executives consider the Office of Student Affairs to be a valuable and necessary resource for the student body at CU-Boulder.

Whereas: The Office of Student Affairs is the only direct advocate for students in the CU-Boulder administration.

Whereas: Last academic year (February/March 1993) the students of the University of Colorado successfully fought to keep the Office of the Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs out of the Boulder campus budgetary cuts.

Whereas: The University of Colorado Student Union Legislative Council passed an Executive Resolution resulting in a vote of no confidence for the Office of the Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs.

Whereas: Individuals in the Office of Student Affairs have acted unethically and unprofessionally in handling the CU Plus/Wardenburg Student Health Center issues by speaking out directly against the student interest and by coercing many involved to change or suppress their free expression concerning the obtaining of CU-Plus at WSHC.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, **THAT:**

SECTION 1: The UCSU Legislative Council condemns the actions of the individuals in the Office of Student Affairs but makes very clear its intentions to maintain the Office and its current structure.

SECTION 2: Although the UCSU Legislative Council supports the structure of the Office of Student Affairs, UCSU in its entirety, demands the adherence to student autonomy by consulting with the appropriate branches of the Student Union in all matters of student fees and student autonomy.

SECTION 3: A copy of this bill will be sent to the Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs office, the Chancellor's Office, the Office of Affirmative Action and Human Services, the President's Office, and to all members of the Board of Regents.

SECTION 4: This resolution takes effect upon passage.
