## BILL HISTORY

The UCSU Recycling and Resource Management Commission was created on April 6, 1989 to implement more environmentally responsible practices in all UCSU Cost Centers. Among the responsibilities of this position are the promotion of a 10% price preference for recycled paper over virgin paper purchases, the use of double-sided copying, the use of recycled paper in copy machines, and the development of a materials use and printing policy for all USCUfunded posters. However, this position was left vacant for several months.
