### A BILL

#### BILL HISTORY

The computing center (CNS) which makes the ballots for the UCSU elections has at numerous times requested at least three weeks to print the ballots. Without three weeks, it is possible that the ballots will not be printed in time for the election.

Last school year the Election Code was changed by the Legislative Council so that this three week period would be met. However, the
Constitution states that the final deadline for referenda will be the Tuesday following the Mandatory Candidates' meeting which
occurs three weeks before the election. Therefore, the deadline for referenda is currently two weeks before the election. While
CNS has been able to print the ballots during the two weeks, there is no guarantee that this quick printing can continue.

This bill asks the voters to change the deadline of submitting referenda to three weeks before the election. There were not enough votes for this referendum to pass in the Fall 1993 election.

## BILL SUMMARY

20 This bill places a question on the Spring 1994 Election ballot asking "Do you approve of changing Article XIII Section A.3 of the 'All petition 22 Constitution from initiated referenda or Constitutional Amendments must be submitted to the Election Commissioner by five o'clock post-meridian on the Tuesday following 24 the day of the mandatory candidates' meeting ..... to 'All petition initiated referenda or Constitutional Amendments must be 26 submitted to the Election Commissioner by the end of the mandatory 28 candidates' meeting'".

30 BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

Section 1: The Legislative Council is instructed to place the following question on the Fall 1993 Election ballot:

"Do you approve of changing Article XIII Section A.3 of the Constitution from "All petition initiated referenda or Constitutional Amendments must be submitted to the Election Commissioner by five o'clock post-meridian on the Tuesday following
