A Bill

Bill History

The UCSU Rules Committee has, in accordance with 39LCB#3, established new By-Laws for the governance of the Student Organizations Committee (SOC).

Bill Summary

This bill amends the UCSU By-Laws.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: This bill amends the UCSU By-Laws as follows.

SECTION 2: **A:** Article VI.B.6 is repealed

B: Article VI.B.5 shall read: Student Organizations Committee

a: The committee shall be composed of eight (8) members. Four shall be appointed by the Legislative Council: two (2) from the Representative Council and two (2) from the Council of Colleges and Schools. One (1) member shall be appointed from Finance Board. One (1) shall be the Public Relations director of UCSU. One (1) shall be a student-at-large appointed by the Executive, and ratified by the Legislative Council. And, one (1) shall be the SOC Chair.

b: The SOC Chair:

i. Shall be hired by the SOC, and ratified by the Legislative Council.

ii. Shall not hold any other paid position in UCSU.

iii. Shall not hold any other voting position in UCSU.

iv. Shall be responsible for fulfilling job requirements as set forth in SOC Guidelines.

c: The SOC shall establish for itself a set of regulations to be known as SOC Guidelines. SOC may amend these regulations at any time with a two-thirds vote of the entire committee.

d: The duties of the SOC are as follows:

i. The SOC shall fund and oversee the optional fee funded student organizations. The SOC Guidelines contains the rules and regulations that define, govern, and outline the duties and responsibilities of the Student Organizations Committee. The SOC shall have the responsibility of monitoring and insuring compliance with the Student Fee Regulations by each group receiving SOC funding.

ii. The SOC shall increase student input in UCSU decision making, and disseminate information on UCSU actions, policies, services, and opportunities to the student body.

e: The SOC is empowered to appoint ex-officio members to itself as it deems necessary.

SECTION 3: This bill shall take effect upon passage.
