A BILL

BILL HISTORY

The United Government of Graduate Students (UGGS) is the only organization which represents all graduate students, graduate business students, and law students on the CU-Boulder campus. UGGS was formed in 1990. At the same time, students approved a referendum to fund the organization. This funding expires in the Spring of 1994.

The numerous accomplishments of UGGS during the past three years include: successful lobbying for a 50 percent waiver of Wardenburg Health Insurance for all Graduate Students with TA, RA, or GPTI appointments, three successful Roundtable Dinners, and leadership in the ongoing fight to reduce the athletic fee. Furthermore, UGGS annually sponsors and organizes a fall picnic, a spring picnic, an income tax workshop, and a financial aid workshop.

By continuing to fund UGGS through referendum money, these projects and others will be able to continue.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill asks for a referenda to be placed on the Spring 1994 ballot which asks for funding for UGGS at the rate of \$.35 per student per semester for the next three years beginning in Fall 1994.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

Section 1: The UCSU Legislative Council will place the following question on the Fall 1993 ballot:

Do you approve of funding for the United Government of Graduate Students (UGGS) at the rate of \$.35 per student per semester for the next three years beginning in Fall 1994?

Section 2: This bill takes effect upon passage.
