A RESOLUTION

Whereas: The actions of President Albino concerning the letter of 7 January 1994 delivered by Vice Chancellor Ekstrand on 14 January to her signed by 78 members of the CU faculty including nine deans calling for her resignation as president of the University of Colorado has caused an atmosphere of divisiveness on the Boulder campus;

Whereas: Maintaining an excellent faculty is essential to the future of the University;

Whereas: The faculty of the University, being most directly in contact with students, are the most important ingredient in giving a quality education to students;

Whereas: Free expression of ideas and opinions has always been of paramount concern to the University of Colorado Student Union; and

Whereas: As students it is our responsibility to try to ensure that we receive the highest quality of education possible;


BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, **THAT:**

Section 1: The University of Colorado Student Union strongly supports the right of CU faculty to free expression in their attempts to voice their concerns to the President of the University of Colorado, Judith Albino, in order to promote a better future for the University.


Section 2: The University of Colorado Student Union condemns the "strong arm" tactics used by the President on 14 January 1994 at a meeting that was intended to be a tactful forum for the Deans and faculty to discuss their private concerns without bringing harm to the University community. We feel that bringing this sensitive issue to the press at this time was premature and has been destructive to University.
