A RESOLUTION

Whereas: The University of Colorado Department of Housing is nationally known for having very strong residence life, student government, and resident advisor community;

Whereas: The Department of Housing has consistently been at ninety percent or above capacity;

Whereas: The Department of Housing, unlike most housing departments, is consistently under budget;

Whereas: The Department of Housing is the University's largest auxiliary, with an annual budget of approximately \$28.5 million;

Whereas: Good management of an auxiliary of this size and nature requires extensive housing and managerial experience;

Whereas: Conducting a limited search would greatly minimize the quality of selection;

Whereas: Within the four campus system, the Boulder campus is the sole campus with a department of housing;

Whereas: The cost of conducting a nation-wide search for a new Director of Housing would be minimal;

Whereas: Policies of the Department of Housing directly affect the lives of nearly seven-thousand students; and


Whereas: The University of Colorado owes its consumers, its students, and the citizens of Colorado personnel of the highest possible quality;

SECTION 1: The University of Colorado Student Union demands that the University conduct a nation-wide search for a new Director of Housing to replace Dan Daniels upon his retirement, through professional Residence Life organizations and through housing departments across the country.


SECTION 2: This resolution takes effect upon passage.


