BILL HISTORY

During budget hearings for FY 1998-99 we created an addendum to the KUCB budget stating, that their budget would be frozen until UCSU Legislative Council approved the Business Plan of the new station and a new budget. Before the Business Plan will be ready for UCSU approval, the General Manager must be hired and the Business Plan finalized. The General Manager was hired August 24, 1998. As of September 1, 1998 KUCB's FY 1997-98 budget will run out of money and since the new budget is frozen they will not have any money to pay their managers or operation costs to continue through September and part of October. The total allocation of student fees to KUCB for FY 1998-99 is \$76,795.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill allocates to KUCB, salary and operational money for the period prior to the approval of the final Business Plan by UCSU.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union that:

Section 1: An amount not to exceed \$23,327.94 will be unfrozen from the KUCB account to be utilized for payroll and operations.

Section 2: This bill takes effect upon passage.
