Section 7 of the bill states that both the funding structure and cost center status of the Women's Resource Center will be revisited by UCSU five years from its creation, in the fall of the 2000 session. On June 18, 1998, 49 Legislative Council Bill #4 was passed creating a dual reporting structure for the Women's Resource Center. This dual reporting to both Student Affairs and UCSU is to be revisited in the fall of 2001. During this analysis, the funding structure and cost center status of the WRC will be visited.
