A BILL

BILL HISTORY

In 1994 the students of the University of Colorado passed a referendum which allotted \$1.72 of student fees per semester to help with the start up of a broadcasting radio station. The total, \$325,763, was to be used for the purchase, start up and other expenses related to bringing a broadcasting radio station to the CU campus. The specific wording of this referendum has been lost, so it is the purpose of this bill to determine how the money will be spent.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill gives control of the KUCB Referendum Account to the KVCU Student General Manager.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

- **Section 1:** This document replaces the original referendum passed in the Spring of 1994 as it has been lost. If the original document is found, this document will take precedence.
- **Section 2:** The total of the referendum fund (\$325,763) will be placed in a KVCU account for startup costs and capital expenses essential to the operation of a broadcast radio station while also conforming to the Student Fee Regulations and the KVCU Mission Statement.
- **Section 3:** All expenditures from the this account must be approved by the Student General Manager of KVCU.
- **Section 4:** If under any circumstance student lose control of KVCU, the remaining portion of this account will be transferred to the UCSU Supplemental Operating Reserve.

Section 5: This bill takes effect immediately.
