BILL HISTORY

The students of the University of Colorado voted in 1994 to approve a fee of \$1.72 a semester that would pay for the purchase of a transmitter, and any other cost directly related to its start up, for KUCB. This fee was collected until the spring semester of 1998, bring the referenda total to \$325,763. UCSU has since lost the specific wording to this referendum. Without this question, UCSU loses it ability to ensure that the referendum is being for the purpose it is intended. Therefor, Legislative Council needs to ensure this money is being used correctly and within the context for which it was passed.

BILL SUMMARY

Since the language of the original referendum has been lost this bill determines the use of that money. Control of this referendum will remain under the control of Legislative Council. Any requests KVCU has for the use of this money shall be made to Legislative Council and shall be only be for capital costs directly related to the operations of a transmitter and the purchase of a new transmitter.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

Section 1:	The KUCB referendum account shall remain under the authority of UCSU's Legislative Council.
Section 2:	KVCU may make capital request directly related to the operations of, or purchase of, a transmitter to Legislative Council.
Section 3:	The KUCB referendum account shall be used only for capital improvements related to a KVCU transmitter and may not be used for any other purpose.
Section 4:	This bill takes effect upon passage.
