BILL HISTORY

One of UCSU's primary goals has been to promote diversity. This issue has become a "buzz" word for candidates committees and university policies. However, this goal has yet to be attained in many university departments, particularly UCSU proper. To fulfill its commitment to diversity, UCSU needs to take a proactive stance in the recruitment and retainment of traditionally underrepresented students as defined by the Diversity Commission mission statement.

BILL SUMMARY

The purpose of this bill is to restructure the Diversity Commission goals and to make a concrete commitment to recruit and retain under represented groups within UCSU.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: Amend bylaw article VIII, letter C, number 1c after "sexual orientation" and before "to act as a check" to read:

To actively recruit and retain traditionally under represented students into UCSU executive and legislative branches, joint boards, committees and commissions; to encourage and promote diversity in UCSU leadership positions;

SECTION 2: This bill takes effect upon passage.
