A BILL

BILL HISTORY

While preparing the student fee presentation for the Regents I found several inconsistencies in the way we assess student fees to students.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill directs the Bursars and Registrars Offices how to redesign their new collection system to accommodate the way we would like to assess student fees.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

- **SECTION 1:** Undergraduates taking one class 5 or fewer credit hours will be assessed base fees.
- **SECTION 2:** Undergraduates taking more than one class or more than 5 credit hours will be assessed full fees.
- **SECTION 3:** For semesters until 24 credit hours are accumulated, Graduate students (not including Law Students) will be charged full fees, for subsequent semesters they will be charged base fees.
- **SECTION 4:** Law School students will pay full fees for their duration.
- **SECTION 5:** Students paying base fees will be allowed to purchase health insurance when they pay the cost of the health insurance along with the Wardenburg portion of the full fees.
- SECTION 6: Continuing Education students can choose to pay full fees or no fees at all.
- **SECTION 7:** ACCESS students (formerly SAVE students) are considered Continuing Education students.
- **SECTION 8**: The new Bursar and Registrar's fee collection system shall be created to accommodate the new student fee collection parameters.

SECTION 9: This bill takes effect upon passage.
