#### A Bill

### **Bill History**

UCSU does not have a clear Representative Council and Council of Colleges and Schools Speaker pay structure. The UCSU By-Laws define the creation and level of salaries as a function of budgetary legislation. Previously, 50LCB#16 established no pay, beginning with the 52<sup>nd</sup> session of Legislative Council (effective November, 1999), for the Representative Council Speaker.

This bill (51LCB #9) under consideration provides the authority for a pay structure for the Representative Council Speaker from it's passage until the point at which 50LCB #16 goes into effect.

### **Bill Summary**

This bill establishes a Representative Council and Council of Colleges and Schools Speaker pay structure.

# THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

**SECTION 1:** The pay rate of Representative Council and Council of Colleges and Schools Speaker will be set by Legislative Council each spring before the first hearing of the UCSU Proper budget at Finance Board. The pay rate will be created by legislation in the form of a secondary measure.

**SECTION 2:** Each Representative Council and Council of Colleges and Schools Speaker will be paid an equal amount of money from the Legislative section of the UCSU Proper budget.

**SECTION 3:** The salaries of Representative Council and Council of Colleges and Schools Speaker will begin the first day of classes for the Fall semester for odd numbered sessions and end the last day of final exams for the same Fall semester. Their salaries will begin the first day of classes for the Spring semester for even numbered sessions and

end the last day of final exams for the same Spring semester. Their salaries will begin the first day of classes for the first term of Summer semester and end the last day of final exams for the last session of Summer semester.

**SECTION 4:** The Legislative Council President will send a memorandum to the Student Organizations Finance Office both beginning and ending the pay for each Representative Council and Council of Colleges and Schools Speaker.

**SECTION 5:** The pay rate of the Representative Council and Council of Colleges and Schools Speaker will be set by Legislative Council each spring before the first hearing of the UCSU Proper budget at Finance Board. The pay rate will be created by legislation in the form of a secondary measure.

**SECTION 6:** This bill takes effect upon passage.
