A Bill

Bill History

The riots that occur in the Boulder Community affect the University of Colorado at Boulder Student Body, The Boulder Community, and the University as a whole. After Regent Jim Martin came to a meeting to discuss a possible solution to stop the riots from occurring, the University of Colorado Student Union pledged to help the administration in preventing the riots.

Bill Summary

This bill pledges to educate students and to work with administration to prevent riots from occurring in the future.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: UCSU will set aside our article space in the Colorado Daily twice a year to run messages that are anti-riots which are violent or physically destructive to persons or property.

SECTION 2: UCSU supports STRICT punishment through Judicial Affairs Process for those involved in the riots that are violent or physically destructive to persons or property.

SECTION 3: UCSU will actively educate students about the possible punishments that could be handed out if caught in a riot that is violent or physically destructive to persons or property.

SECTION 4: This bill takes effect upon passage.
