Bill history

A.I.E.S.E.C. Colorado is an organization that sends students abroad for paid internships. In addition to being the largest student-run organization in the country, it is affiliated with more than 80 nations. The group has been recognized nationally for the number of students it has sent overseas. Funding for the organization will decrease applicants' costs, thus representing the University of Colorado on a global scale, and will subsidize the cost of attending national and regional conferences, representing the University on a national level. The organization has attempted to obtain referendum funds in the past but has failed because of insufficient student turn-out.

Bill summary

The bill places A.I.E.S.E.C. Colorado on the Spring 2000 U.C.S.U. ballot.

Therefore, Be it enacted by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union that:

section 1: The Spring 2000 U.C.S.U. ballot will include the following question:

"Do you approve of the 25 cents per semester for four years for A.I.E.S.E.C. Colorado?"

"A.I.E.S.E.C. is a non-profit, student-run organization dedicated to promoting international awareness through paid international internships. The 25 cents will subsidize the cost of searching for students' paid international internships, work visas, and friends in 84 countries.

"A.I.E.S.E.C. is the world's largest student-run organization, with presence in 84 countries and more than 80,000 members. The objective of A.I.E.S.E.C. is to promote international awareness through cultural exchange. Every year, A.I.E.S.E.C. student members find paid internships all over the world.

"A.I.E.S.E.C. Colorado offers students the opportunity to run the organization, as well as partake in a paid international internship. A.I.E.S.E.C. provides international experience through business, technical, teaching, and other fields of internships."

section 2: The election commissioner will ensure the bill's proper attachment to the Spring 2000 U.C.S.U. ballot.

section 3: The bill takes effect upon passage.
