**Bill history**

**Bill summary**

**This bill places CU speech and Debate referenda on the Spring 2000 UCSU ballot for renewal.**

**Therefore, be it enacted by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, that:**

**Section 1:** The Spring 2000 UCSU ballot will include the following question:

Purpose: CU Speech and Debate is a group open to all students. The team competes in regional and national speech and debate tournaments. With a long tradition of excellence, the team has represented CU well with three national championships in the last three years. The team is also actively involved in public service, running Colorado’s largest high school tournament and supporting public debates on important national and regional issues. Funding will allow the team to continue to run collegiate and high school tournaments as well as represent the University of Colorado on the national competitive speech and debate circuit.

Budget: Funds will be used for transportation, lodging, mailing and photocopies, entry fees for competitions, running high school and college tournaments fees to national speech and debate organizations.

**Section 2:** The election commissioner will ensure the bill’s proper attachment to the Spring 2000 UCSU ballot.

**Section 3:** The bill must be introduced for first reading and then voted on formally for second reading.

**Section 4:** The bill takes effect upon passage.
