A Bill

Bill history

52 L.C.B. 22 states that the Legislative Council can allow (via the passage of a bill) student and referenda groups to claim representation of the entire student body on a particular issue. Such a process needs to be explicitly stated in the U.C.S.U. Bylaws. The most efficient way to do so is to define bills which bestow such representation as needing a "secondary reading/measure" (i.e., such a bill would require two readings before the Legislative Council).

Bill summary

This bill amends the U.C.S.U. Bylaws to include bills dealing with groups wishing to claim representation of the entire student body under "Secondary Readings/Measures" (Article III, Section 7).

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union that:

section 1: Article III, Section A, sub-section 7, point B of the U.C.S.U. Bylaws be amended to include a sub-point v, which states "Any bills which allow for a student or referendum group to claim representation of the entire student body on a particular issue"

section 2: 52 L.C.B. 23 takes effect upon passage.
