A Bill

Bill history

The bill may be known as the UCSU Funding Process Investigation Act of 2000. In Spring 2000, UCSU is undergoing a comprehensive review of all of its operations. One of the areas of particular concern is the way UCSU funds student groups. Some student groups complain that the funding process is currently too burdensome and difficult. Various UCSU funding bodies have conflicting regulations that cause problems for students, Student Organizations Finance Office (SOFO), student groups, and members of Council.

Bill summary

The bill creates a committee of three members of Legislative Council to recommend reform of the UCSU funding process. The recommendation will be presented to Legislative Council on 1 May 2000 for discussion and possible adoption.

Therefore, be it enacted by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, that:
section 1: UCSU creates a committee of three members of Council to provide a recommendation for how to reform the UCSU funding process because of Legislative Council on 1 May 2000.

section 2: The recommendation will include information about Representative Council, the Council of Colleges and Schools, Program Council, Student Organizations Commission, Cultural Events Board, local college and school student governments, and Supplementary Operating Reserve funding of student groups and programming.

section 3: The recommendation will address how such funding bodies may better integrate their functions to provide easier service to the student body.

section 4: The recommendation will include input from the Student Organizations Finance Office (SOFO).

section 5: The bill takes effect upon passage.
