Legislative Council has had varying success with the two Vice President model. Recently, it has been unnecessary to have two Vice Presidents. There is not enough work to merit the elevated status of Vice President. Further, it is unreasonable for UCSU to pay two individuals a $\$ 250$ monthly salary with no accountability mechanisms.

## Bill Summary

This bill eliminates two Legislative Council Vice Presidents.

## THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: Legislative Council will have one Vice President.
SECTION 2: Their duties will be defined by Legislative Council through the UCSU Legislative Council Standing Rules, UCSU By Laws or other mechanisms.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.
