A Bill

53 Legislative Council Bill #4 may be known as the Agreement to Conditional Membership in the Colorado Student Association (CSA). CSA is comprised of nearly every major student government or student union in the state of Colorado. The organization has representation at the Colorado Commission on Higher Education (CCHE) as well as contact with the Governor. CSA works regularly at the Colorado General Assembly on issues affecting Higher Education.

Bill Summary

The University of Colorado Student Union would join the Colorado Student Association for a one-year conditional membership. UCSU would attend board meetings as an exofficio member. UCSU would not have to pay any membership dues during this period. UCSU would have access to any and all resources of CSA. A referendum asking the student body whether UCSU should join CSA permanently as a dues paying member for a cost of approximately \$22,004 which would be assessed at a rate per student, would be placed on the ballot of the UCSU Spring 2001 Elections.

THEREFORE, be it enacted by the University of Colorado Student Union Legislative Council, THAT:

Section I: the University of Colorado Student Union will become a conditional member of the Colorado Student Association for a period of one year,

Section 2: a referendum will then be placed on the ballot during the UCSU spring 2001 Elections for the student body to consider a permanent membership status with CSA, and,

Section 3: this bill takes effect upon passage.
