A BILL

BILL HISTORY

In 1994 the students of the University of Colorado passed a referendum that allotted \$1.72 of student fees per semester to help with the purchase and operation of a broadcasting radio station. The legislation establishing this account (LC49B11) stipulates that the funds may only be spent on 'startup costs and capital expenses essential to the operation of a broadcast radio station.' This bill expands the scope of the Referendum by specifically allowing KVCU to use it for fundraising activities. This will help KVCU to continue meeting its self-generated revenue goals and better serve the student population.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill allows KVCU to use their Referendum Account to pay for fundraising items and expenses.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

Section 1: This document amends only Section 2 of LC49B11.

Section 2: Section 2 of LC49B11 will be changed so that 'for startup costs and capital expenses' will be replaced with 'for startup costs, capital expenses and fundraising expenditures, including promotional items.'

Section 3: This bill takes effect immediately.
