A Bill

Bill History

Our current Student Fee Regulations include certain sections that are state law, however the laws have changes and we have failed to change the SFR. Section 2.3.7 in the SFR is one such stipulation that is no longer applicable. The latest CCHE regulations no longer restrict the use of student fees for recruitment.

Bill Summary

This bill removes section 2.3.7 from the UCSU Student Fee Regulations, which states: University policies and practices with respect to recruiting of prospective students are subject to regulation internally as well as by the Colorado Commission on Higher Education. Any request for student fee support of a recruiting activity intending to encourage non-UCB students to attend UCB will not be considered except upon written endorsement by the Chancellor of the Boulder Campus.

THEREFORE, be it enacted by the University of Colorado Student Union Legislative Council, THAT:

- **Section 1:** Removes the gavel from section 2.3.7 from the University of Colorado Student Union Student Fee Regulations.
- **Section 2:** Remove section 2.3.7 from the University of Colorado Student Union Student Fee's Regulations.
- **Section 3:** Renumber all following clauses accordingly.
- **Section 4:** All student fee expenditures used for recruiting purposes following the passage of this bill shall be subject to approval of Legislative Council.

Section 5: This bill goes into effect upon passage.
