Representative Inductions

BILL HISTORY

Currently, there is no formalized procedure to inaugurate representatives. An oath of office would dignify the position as well as hold representatives accountable for knowing the duties of their position.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill will create a procedure and oath to induct newly elected representatives into office.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the University of Colorado Student Union Legislative Council, THAT:

Section 1: This bill shall take effect upon passage and signature by the legislative council president.

Section 2: The representatives, before entering upon their duties, shall take and subscribe to the following oath or affirmation: "I do solemnly swear that I will uphold the constitution of the University of Colorado Student Union, in the spirit in which it was created. I will perform the duties and responsibilities of Representative at large of the University of Colorado Student Union faithfully and to the best of my ability." Said oath or affirmation shall be taken at the first legislative council meeting attended by the new representative(s).

Section 3: The Presiding Officer of the Legislative Council shall administer the Oath at the beginning of each session or when a new member joins thereafter
