## **A Bill to Repeal 70LCB11**

### **Bill History**

**Safety Initiatives Coalition** created in **70LCB11 - SIC.**

#### **Summary**

The bill created the Safety Initiatives Coalition (SIC) in response to a series of safety incidents including sexual assaults and BMIs. The bill outlines an extensive list of organizations that should be offered positions within this group, including:

## **Bill Summary**

This bill effectively repeals and nullifies 70LCB11 and dissolves the Safety Initiatives Coalition.

Whereas, the group created in the bill no longer remains in commission;

Whereas, many of the cited tasks are carried out instead by other offices and groups around campus, including the CUSG Safety Buffs Coalition, the Office of Student Affairs, the Gender Justice League, etc.;

Whereas, the structure of the Safety Initiatives Coalition does not guarantee the participation of any groups, making it difficult for them to have a meaningful impact on campus;

Whereas, continuity remains a problem with this bill, given CUSG turn-over;

**THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED THAT:**

**Section 1:** 70LCB11 is hereby repealed and nullified, and the Safety Initiatives Coalition dissolved.

**Section 2:** This bill shall take effect upon passage by the Legislative Council and upon either obtaining the signatures of two Tri-Executives or the lapse of six days without actions by the Tri-Executives.






