Bill Summary

The attached spreadsheet is the official document containing all approved allocations for the 2014-2015 FY Student Fee Package. Adjustments may be made to account for changes to the Recreation Center Renovation/Expansion Fee, police recharge and the allocation to CU Colleges and Schools.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED

\$6,795,141 shall be funded through Student Fees to the Cost Center.

Section 3: Environmental Center (E-Center)

\$1,059,422 shall be funded through Student Fees to the Cost Center.

Section 4: University of Colorado Student Government (CUSG)

\$552,704 shall be funded through Student Fees to the Cost Center.

Section 5: Student Organization Funding Office (SOFO)

\$463,477 shall be funded through Student Fees to the Cost Center.
