

TO A TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR

Referendum for the purpose of changing Article XIV effective date and insertion of Article XV in the proposed Constitution as follows:
A REFERENDUM FOR THE PURPOSE OF A CHANGE IN ARTICLE FOURTEEN — EFFECTIVE DATE, AND THE INSERTION OF ARTICLE FIFTEEN — AMENDMENT PROCEDURES FOR THE PURPOSE OF CORRECTING TYPOGRAPHICAL ERRORS IN THE OFFICIAL VERSION OF THE UCSU PROPOSED CONSTITUTION.

Article Fourteen — Effective Date

The ASUC Constitution in effect prior to ratification of this constitution shall remain in effect until one minute past midnight on May 2, 1974 subject to the transition provisions of this constitution described in Article sixteen — Transition Provisions.

Article Fifteen — Amendments Procedures

- Amendments shall follow the same procedure as referendum as it regards the student body.
- Amendments can be initiated by the Executive or the Executive Council with approval of 2/3 of the Executive Council present and voting.
- Two weeks must elapse between proposal and voting on the amendments during which time publicity shall be given on the amendment.
- Amendments must be approved by a majority of the voters and have at least 1000 favorable votes.

- D. The order of succession shall be Vice-President and... Director is unable to fulfill his duties as President, the Executive Council shall call new elections for the Executive to fill the remainder of the term, within...

Article Three — The Legislative Branch

- The Executive Council
 - The Executive Council shall consist of the members of the Representative Council and the Local Council.
 - Responsibilities
 - The Executive Council shall appoint all Joint Board members, except the Representative Council members and the Finance Director. These appointments shall be approved by a majority of the Council.
 - The Executive Council shall ratify commission directors and Representative Council appointments to the Joint Boards by a majority vote.
 - The Executive Council shall allocate money to student groups.
 - The Executive Council shall initiate referendum, initiate policies, review student fee budget, establish priorities for the Joint Boards, and initiate any other measures deemed necessary.
 - The Executive Council can override an Executive veto by a 2/3 vote of the entire Council.
 - Executive Council meetings
 - Meetings shall be held bi-monthly during the first and third week of each month.
 - Meetings shall be presided over by a President and Vice-President Pro-Tem of the Council.
 - Quorum shall consist of 1/2 the number of the Council members from both Councils.
- The Representative Council
 - The Representative Council shall consist of ten members elected at-large by a fair system of proportional representation. The term of office shall be one year. Five seats shall be elected in the spring, and five seats shall be elected in the autumn.
 - Responsibilities
 - Each Representative Council member shall sit on one Joint Board.
 - The Representative Council shall establish University-wide priorities.
 - Representative Council meetings
 - Meetings shall be held bi-monthly during the second and fourth week of each month.
 - Quorum shall consist of a majority of Council.
- The Local Council
 - Each Local Council member shall be elected in accordance with procedures established in her/his individual constituency.

ON THE REFERENDUM

- The Student Health Board shall decide policy for university health
 - They shall design and recommend the health budget
- E. University Board of the Environment
- The UBE shall consist of five students
 - One to be appointed by the Executive from the Representative Council
 - Four members appointed by the Executive Council.
 - Duties
 - The UBE shall decide priorities for environmental policy.
 - The UBE shall design and recommend the budget.
- F. Recreation Board
- The Recreation Board shall consist of Five members
 - One to be appointed by the Executive from the Representative Council
 - Four members appointed by the Executive from the Executive Council.
 - Duties
 - The Recreation Board shall set up university recreation policy.
 - The Recreation Board shall design and recommend the recreation budget.

Article Eight — Commissions

- A. The following commissions shall exist:
- Housing
 - Affirmative Action
 - Academic Affairs
 - Community Relations
 - Research
 - Student Public Relations
- B. Other commissions can be established by the Executive Council by a majority vote of the Council, subject to Executive veto as with legislation.
- C. Each commissioner must be appointed by the Executive and ratified by a majority of the Executive Council, present and voting.

Article Nine — Removal and Impeachment

- Impeachment
 - Impeachment proceedings shall be initiated and conducted by the Executive Council.
 - Impeachment will require a 2/3 vote of the entire Council
 - Officers subject to impeachment:
 - President
 - Vice-President(s)
 - Local Representative
 - Justices
 - Representative Representative
 - Election Commissioner
 - Grounds for Impeachment shall be failure to substantially fulfill the duties of her/his office including absence from four consecutive meetings without substantial excuse.
- Removal of Appointed Officers
 - Joint Boards
 - Any Joint Board Member from the Representative Council may be removed by the Executive Council.
 - 2/3 of Representative Council present and voting are required for recall.
 - Executive appointments may be removed by the Executive.
 - Executive Council appointments may be removed by a 2/3 vote, present and voting, of the Executive Council.
- Recall
 - Representative Council
 - The recall of a Representative may be initiated by a petition of her/her constituency containing signatures of at least equal to 33 per cent of the votes cast in the previous election for that seat.
 - Recall procedures may not be initiated until at least two months after the original election.
 - Upon validation of the petition by the Election Commission an election within the constituency shall determine if the Representatives shall be recalled. A majority of the persons voting is needed for recall.
 - If the Representative is recalled, and an election to fill the vacancy will be held within three weeks of the recall.
 - Local Council
 - Each Local School will establish and carry out its own recall proceedings for its Local Representatives.

Article Ten — Vacancies

- Representative Council
 - Before her/his resignation, the resigning representative may designate a replacement subject to approval by 1/3 remainder of the Representative Council.
 - If the representative, upon resignation, does not designate a replacement or if vacancy
